DIRECTIONS

TO CHECK-IN FOR OUR CRUISES FROM LAHAINA HARBOR AND PACIFIC WHALE FOUNDATION'S OCEAN STORE IN LAHAINA

For all trips (except select whalewatches, see note below) out of Lahaina Harbor, check in is at the Pacific Whale Foundation Ocean Store at 612 Front Street in Lahaina. Please see directions below.

If you should ever need additional help locating us, please call us at 808-249-8811 from Maui. Our offices are open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.

From Kihei/Wailea:



Take Highway 31 (Piilani Highway), going past the turn for the Mokulele Highway. At this point, Highway 31 becomes Highway 310 (North Kihei Road). Continue straight on this road.



You'll pass the Kealia Pond National Wildlife Refuge. Continue onward until the road ends.



At this intersection turn left onto Highway 30 (Honoapiilani Highway)

Continue on Highway 30, past Ma'alaea and Olowalu, into Lahaina. Turn left on Prison Street, then go towards the ocean until you see the public parking area on your left. From the parking lot, walk down Front Street towards the harbor for about 50 yards to the Pacific Whale Foundation Ocean Store.

Total estimated drive time: 30-45 min

NOTE:

DO NOT LEAVE CAMERAS OR OTHER VALUABLES IN YOUR PARKED CAR ANYWHERE IN HAWAII.

DIRECTIONS

From Lahaina / Ka'anapali:

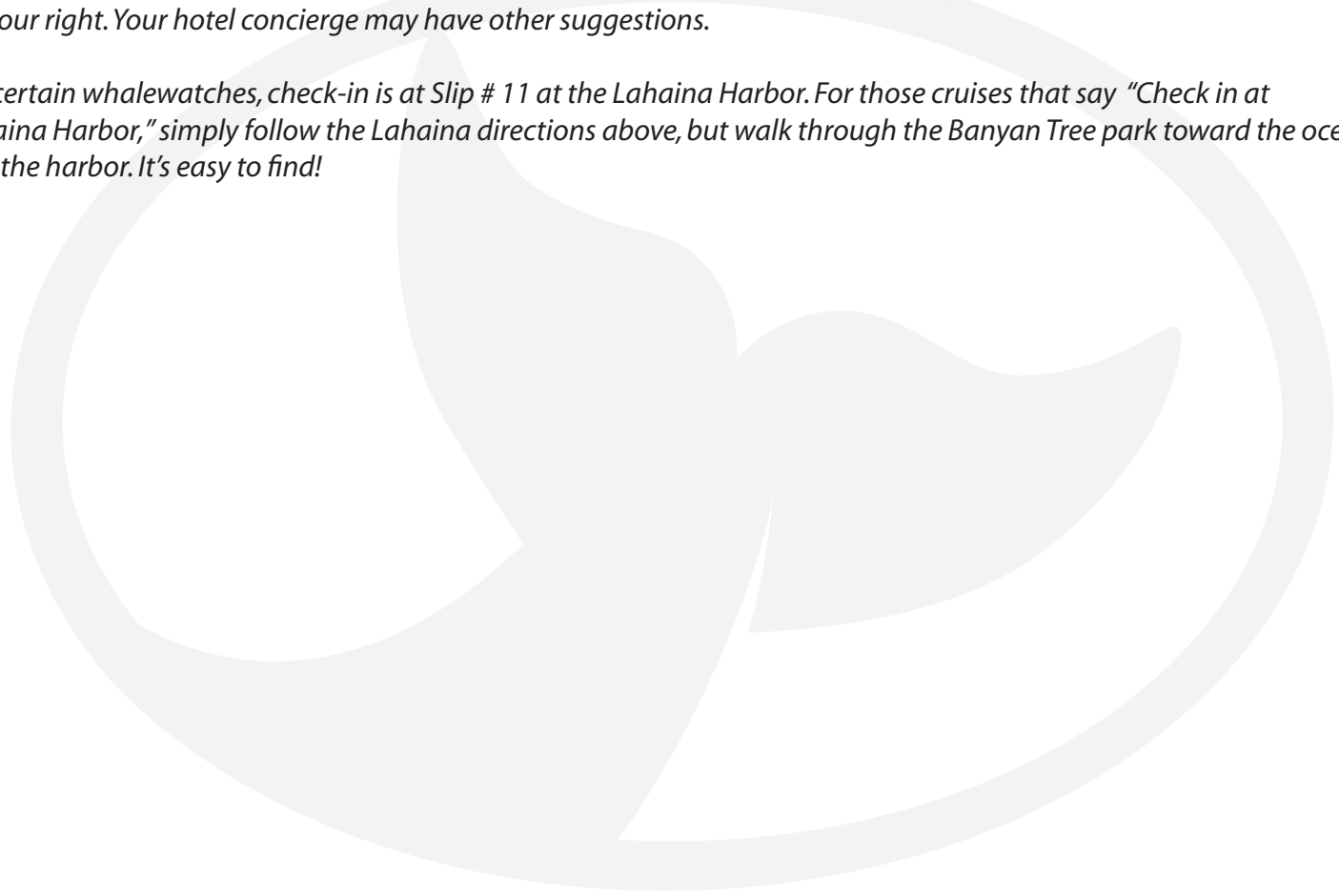
Take Highway 30 (Honoapiilani Highway) until you reach Prison Street. Turn right, then go towards the ocean until you see the public parking area on your left. From the parking lot, walk down Front Street towards the harbor for about 50 yards to the Pacific Whale Foundation Ocean Store.

Total estimated drive time: 10-15 min

Please note:

Leave extra time if you wish to find free parking in Lahaina. Some suggestions: From Route 30, turn onto Dickenson Street. Turn right into small one lane street by Lahaina Divers and Robert Lyn Nelson gallery. Public parking lot is down the street on your right. Your hotel concierge may have other suggestions.

For certain whalewatches, check-in is at Slip # 11 at the Lahaina Harbor. For those cruises that say "Check in at Lahaina Harbor," simply follow the Lahaina directions above, but walk through the Banyan Tree park toward the ocean and the harbor. It's easy to find!
