



Pacific Whale Foundation Scholarships for Keiki Programs Application Criteria for Classroom Teachers

With the understanding that many families are facing financial hardship, Pacific Whale Foundation has raised limited funds within our local and broader membership community to defray student costs associated with our Keiki Whalewatch program. While committed to providing access to standards-based, experiential outdoor learning to the greatest number of students possible regardless of the ability to pay, we are unable to fully subsidize the cost of providing these programs. It is our hope that organizations within the school community (PTA, PCNC, etc.) can contribute to the program and/or transportation costs if students are unable to pay.

Requests for assistance will be considered based on the following:

1. Demonstration of financial need as determined by school's Title I designation.
2. Commitment on part of teacher to make environmental education a priority as demonstrated by past participation with Pacific Whale Foundation or other nature-based learning experiences.
3. Submission of a completed scholarship application. We appreciate your efforts to provide an invaluable learning experience for your students. All requests are kept strictly confidential.

Priority will be given to applications received by January 15, 2021. As funds are limited, subsequent disbursements may be made based on remaining funds.
