Location: The Ma'alaea Harbor Shops

Notes: This site is located nearby a bus station.

Facilities: Parking, public restrooms available. Elevators within walking distance.

Location: Ho'okipa Beach Park, North Shore Maui, 2 miles east of the town of Pa'ia

Notes: This site is located off Hana Highway and only accessible by car (no public transport).

Facilities: Parking, lifeguards, showers, pavilion, picnic tables, port-a-potties.

Location: Kihei Surfside

Notes: This site is located nearby a bus station.

Facilities: Gravel public parking available at the Mana Kai and Days Inn. Showers and port-a-potty available.

Location: Launiupoko Beach Park just south of Lahaina

Notes: There is no public transport available in this area.

Facilities: Parking, restrooms, sandy beach, picnic tables.

Location: Makaluapuna Point (also called Dragon's Teeth) in Kapalua

Notes: Requires ~ 15 min walk over uneven, rocky terrain from parking to lookout site.

Facilities: None at site. No public transport.

Location: Marriott's Maui Ocean Club, Ka'anapali

Notes: Parking is available (no public transport).

Facilities: None at this site for public use.

Location: McGregor Point along Pali/Honoapi'ilani Hwy

Notes: There is no public transportation available

Facilities: Parking is free but can be crowded, no restrooms.

Location: Pohaku Park (S-turns), Kahana

Notes: This site is located nearby a bus station. This site requires a walk over rocky terrain; persons with mobility issues should select a different site.

Facilities: Showers, bathrooms, parking.

Location: Polo Beach – Wailea

Notes: No public transportation nearby

Facilities: Public restrooms and showers, free parking

Location: Pu'u Olai - Red Hill, Makena

IMPORTANT NOTE: This site requires a ~40 minute steep hike uphill at a brisk pace (to be there on time), with a steep downward angle on the way down. It is physically strenuous, and this site is not for individuals with mobility or joint issues. There are no facilities available directly at the survey site. Please consider physical limitations before signing up for this site.

Facilities: None. Parking on a dirt road (no public transport).

Location: The Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale National Marine Sanctuary Visitors Center (Kihei Sanctuary)

Notes: This site is located nearby a bus station.

Facilities: Parking, public restrooms available. This site is wheelchair accessible.
